

## Learning for Life KS4 Learning Overview

At KS4 the students have the opportunity to gain an Entry Level 3 Qualification. The **highlighted foci** cover the curriculum from the WJCE Entry Level 3 in Personal and Social Development. Every year a selection of students' work is moderated by the Welsh Examination Board. Our Careers lessons follow guidance provided by the Gatsby Benchmarks.

We may also have support from external providers such as 'Community Capacity Builders CIC', 'Healthy Services in Schools' and 'Brook'. Therefore, the order of delivery may sometimes change.

We also offer a 'catch-up' day for all students in Year 11 after they have finished their GCSE examinations. This is an important opportunity for students to participate in a number of workshops on topics they may have missed due to extended times out of school or before they joined JPC.

PSHEE and Careers lessons are taught by a variety of teachers in the school. Our Learning Mentors cover our assembly themes *[see separate table]* and also support the delivery of our 'Preparation for Adult Hood' and the practical elements of the WJEC Entry Level 3 qualification.
