Theme: Perspective Taking	Smart Guesses (inferring)	
<p>Aims:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> For students to know what a 'smart guess' or 'educated guess' is e.g. using all the information that you have to make a guess. For students to be aware of the different types of information that are available e.g. word meaning, body language, facial expression, eye contact, intention/motive, social context/environment. For the students to be able to make 'smart guesses' in set activities. For students to be able to provide information to enable others to make 'smart guesses' within set activities.
