Theme: Perspective Taking

Personal Memories of Others

"The last time you saw a person is the first memory that you have of them the next time you see them."

Dr Carol Prutting (Winner pg. 57)

Aims:

- For students to be able to share an interest or something that they like with a peer.
- For students to be able to recall three things about a peer.
- For students to be able to ask a peer a question about the other person's interests/preferences.

Activity	Procedure	Equipment
Memory Game	<p>Remind the students of the bean bag game from last session.</p> <p>Sit in a circle. Place the cards that you wrote on last week in the centre of the group. Take it in turns to take a card – the student must try to match the interest with a peer. If they have their own interest, get them to choose another card.</p> <p>At the end of the activity, ask the students how it felt when another person remembered what they like. If this is too difficult provide a forced choice e.g. Did it feel good or bad?</p>	Cards with interests written on them
