

## Social Thinking

### Session E

**Theme: Perspective Taking**

**Lesson's Theme: Vocabulary of Perspective**

#### Aims:

- For students to be aware of the concepts 'know', 'think' and 'guess'.
- For the students to be able to identify what one story character knows about another character/situation.
- For students to be able to suggest what one story character might think about another character/situation (infer).
- For students to be able to guess what might happen next in the story.

Activity	Procedure	Equipment
Review ST vocabulary and cards  (2 mins)	Show cards & discuss examples	Symbols
Discussion of social situation cards	<p>Choose a picture of a social situation.</p> <p>Encourage students to say what they 'know' (fact) about the picture.</p> <p>Move on to discuss what they 'think' (infer) the story characters are:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"><li>Thinking,</li><li>Thinking about the other character,</li><li>Thinking about what the other character is thinking about their own thoughts (only for groups that are doing really well!)</li></ol> <p>Next encourage the students to 'guess' (predict) what will happen next. Try to think of three positive, three negative and three neutral outcomes.</p>	<p>Social situation pictures (you can use my examples or your own)</p> <p>Symbols</p>
